

BACK POCKET 9-BALL

RULES :

- 1.) Flip a coin to determine breaker
- 2.) Breaker chooses one of two kitchen corner pockets to be his "Back Pocket"
- 3.) Opponent gets the other kitchen corner pocket as his "Back Pocket"
- 4.) Play regular 9-Ball rules except to win you must make the 9Ball in YOUR Back Pocket.
- 5.) Winner breaks. Winner racks.
- 6.) IF.....
 - a) you make the 9ball , on the break, or at any time following a legal hit, in YOUR Back Pocket, you win.
 - b) you make the 9ball, on the break, or at any time, WITH OR WITHOUT A LEGAL HIT, in your OPPONENTS Back Pocket, HE/SHE wins.
 - c) you make the 9ball, from a legal hit, ON THE BREAK, in a NON Back Pocket, it is spotted. Shooter continues. Any other time, the 9 is spotted and the shooter loses his turn UNLESS HE MADE ANOTHER BALL from a legal hit.
- 7.) Race to 6
- 8.) \$40 Entry Fee
- 9.) No HCP for match scoring....HCP's apply for 'Break & Run Pot' qualifying
- 10.) Intentionally fouling by moving the 9ball is not allowed. Opponent gets ball in hand and can put the 9ball back where it was.

How To Win The \$1000 Pot:

- 1.) 'A' players must run 4 racks from the break
- 2.) 'B' players must run 3 racks from the break
- 3.) If you win the pot you get **75%**....YOUR OPPONENT gets **25%**
- 4.) One pot per tournament
 - a) Tournament bracket is drawn
 - b) First Round matches are called
 - c) Play begins
 - d) All matches in the first round are playing to win the pot
 - e) If more than one player qualifies, the pot is split proportionally
 - f) If someone wins the pot, the pot is 'spent' for this tournament
 - g) If no one wins the pot in the first round everyone gets another shot in the second round. Then the third round. Then the fourth round. etc etc
 - h) The pot is at risk each round until won.
 - i) A new \$1000 pot starts next tournament.
- 5.) After the \$1000 pot is fully funded, it will grow with each tournament until won
